Femke used to work in a food company. She knew her job inside out, but she never understood why her employer always insisted on the use of protective glasses, when she was only handling 'food stuff'. Until a bottle with concentrated citric acid slipped out of her hand and splashed on the floor, Femke got a bead of it in her eye and had to be rushed into the hospital with serious burns. She partly regained her sight a few months later, but she will always have to wear those dark glasses. Furthermore she now has to make it on her own with a much lower replacement income.

Do you want to drastically reduce your chances of having an accident? Then always follow the safety regulations and use the correct protective equipment! Ask your manager for advice if you're not sure what the exact requirements are in your specific work environment.
